1 **FREE PARKING & MEALS**

Both the bus driver and the tour operator will receive a free meal at Academy Food + Drink, located across from the complimentary bus parking area.

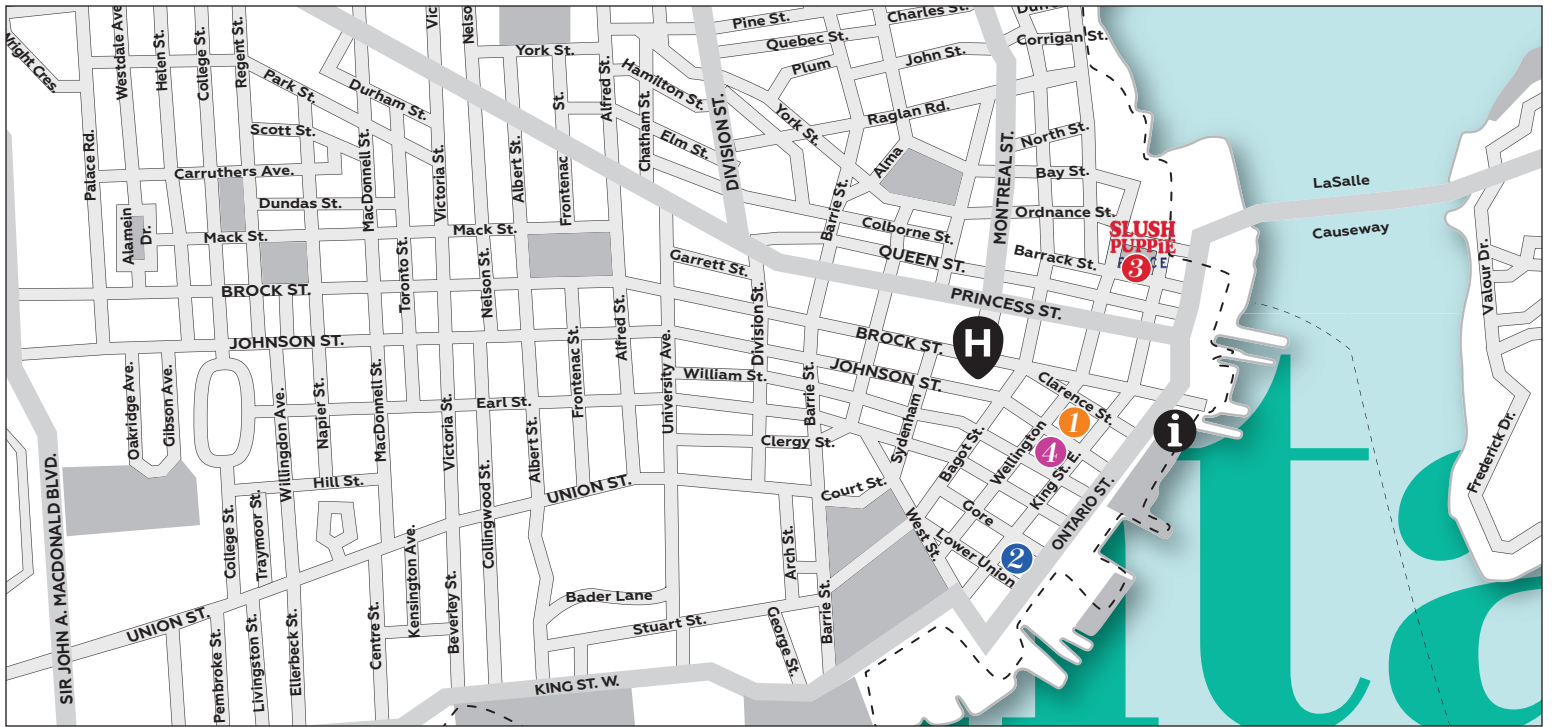
2 **FREE GUIDED TOUR**

An ambassador from our Visitor Information Centre will walk your guests and the tour guide from the bus parking area to the waterfront, sharing history about Kingston City Hall along the way. (5-10 minutes)

① KING STREET

Three parking spaces – 294 King Street East
Next to Kingston Custom House National Historic Site:
complimentary 24-hour bus parking.

② GREAT LAKES MUSEUM + S.S. KEEWATIN

One drop-off parking space. 15 minutes max. – 55 Ontario St.
The Great Lakes Museum will have a new 15-minute bus parking space directly in front of the museum at 55 Ontario St. for drop-offs.

③ SLUSH PUPPIE PLACE

Two parking spaces – 1 The Tragically Hip Way
24-hour maximum parking most days. During major event days, lot must be vacated by 4 pm. See lot signage for details.
Additionally, Slush Puppie Place is designated for overflow bus parking if the King St. East spaces are full.

④ JOHNSON STREET

Two parking spaces – 70 Johnson St.
Beside St. George's Anglican Cathedral on Johnson St. between Wellington St. and King St. complimentary 9 am–5 pm.
